TV rating consent [Years 7-9]

As part of their SIDE program, students listen, view, and discuss texts such as films, documentaries, episodes on streaming services or DVDs. Many texts used in classrooms have a G rating and contain content of very mild impact. Parents and guardians can be confident their children can view G rated texts. On occasions, a text with a PG classification is felt to be appropriate for the school program. Content with a PG classification is mild in impact but some students under the age of 15 may find it confusing or upsetting.

We seek permission for your child to work with texts that have a PG classification.

- PG rated texts - mild in impact but some students under the age of 15 may find it confusing or upsetting.
- M rated texts - moderate in impact and not recommended for students under 15 years of age.
